



The Jaques Student Art Gallery Competition

Introduction:

The Jaques Student Art Gallery competition is funded through an endowment to the Shelby County Schools Education Foundation given by the Rosemary M. and James A. Jaques Charitable Trust. Each year judges have the opportunity to select one high school student and one middle school student who will receive a \$200.00 award to help pursue their interest in art. The selected students' art teacher will also receive a \$200.00 award. The artwork submitted to the competition by the winning students will be framed or otherwise prepared for permanent display and will become the property of Shelby County Schools. The artwork will be displayed in the Jaques Students Art Gallery at the central administration building of Shelby County Schools.

The criteria for submitting an entry to the competition are:

1. The student must be currently enrolled in a Shelby County School.
2. The student must be currently enrolled in an art course at the school.
3. The student must be willing for his/her original work to become the property of Shelby County Schools.
4. The student must exhibit and interest in continuing to advance his/her interest in art.
5. The student must complete the entire application form and submit the application & artwork to the SCSEF office before the deadline.

Deadline for entries is **March 30, 2012**.
